We also feature new books along with new reports and journal articles from Aotearoa New Zealand and around the world.

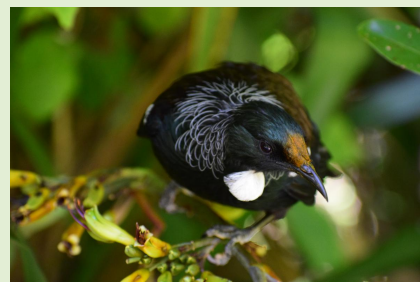

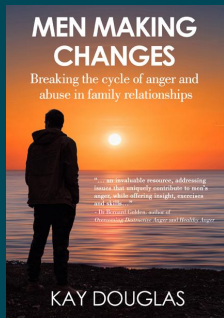
Webinar recording now available

The recording of this webinar, organised by Ngā Wai a Te Tūi and supported through a partnership with NZFVC, is now available online.

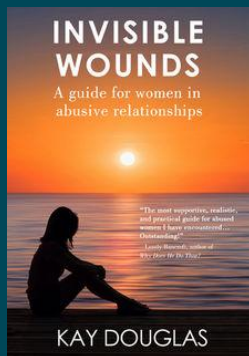


New books to borrow
