We hope that you managed to find some time to take a break with whānau and friends and that you are feeling refreshed and rested.

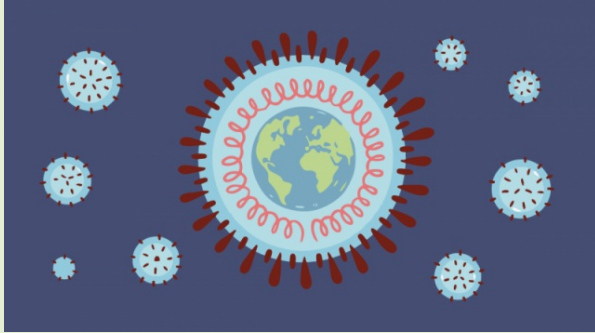
