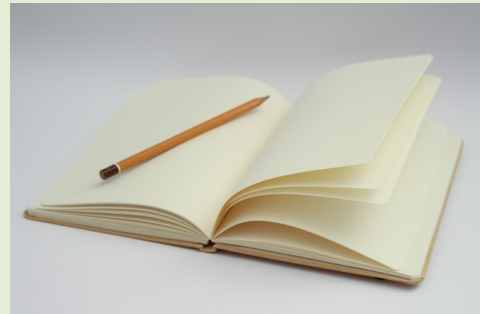


### **New Disability Toolkit for developing policy; reports on disability and violence**

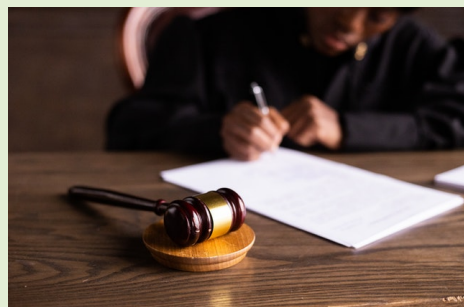
